An abandon-ment of the land for more than six months works a forfeiture of the claim. Further, within two years from the expiraabda tion of the said five years he must file proof of his actual settlement and cultivation, failing to do which, his entry will be canceled. If the settler does not wish to remain five years on his tract, he can, at any time after fourteen months, pay for it with eash or land warrants, upon making proof of settlement and of residence and cultivation from date of filing affidavit to the time of payment. 0 6-012
