

Certificate of Service.

To all whom it may concern,

This is to certify: That John Timmings who was enrolled on the 1st day of August one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, to serve three years, was discharged on the 1st day of August 1864, by reason of muster out of company at near Petersburg Virginia, while holding the grade of Private in Company "H" 63^d Regiment of Pennsylvania Volunteers, and serving honorably in the military service of the United States.

This certificate is given upon evidence that the original discharge has been lost or destroyed, and in all cases upon the conditions imposed by the Act of Congress approved March 3, 1873, that it "shall not be accepted as a voucher for the payment of any claim against the United States for pay, bounty, or other allowance, or as evidence, in any other case."
