KNOW YE, That Pizarro Cook  
 a Private of Captain Henry A Chase  
 Company A, 31st Regiment of Wisconsin Infantry  
**VOLUNTEERS**, who was enrolled on the 9th day of August  
 one thousand eight hundred and 62 to serve Three years  
 or during the war, is hereby DISCHARGED from the service of the United States this 20th  
 day of June 1865, at Near Louisville Ky  
 by reason of Gen Order No 96 of 1865 War Dept

(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Pizarro Cook was born in Bayoga Co  
 in the State of New York, is 35 years of age,  
6 feet — inches high, Slight  
 complexion, Grey eyes, Dark hair, and by occupation,  
 when enrolled, a Surveyor
