Know ye, That George W. Rockafield, a Private of Captain Lafayette Bitchtel's Company (H) Eighth Regiment of Ohio Cavalry Volunteers, who was ^{enrolled} ^{as a recruit} on the eighth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, to serve one year or during the war, is hereby discharged from the service of the United States, this Thirtieth day of July, 1865, at Clarksburg, W. Va. by reason of Special Order, No 143, C. S. Dept. W. Va. (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said George W. Rockafield was born in Greene Co. in the State of Ohio, is nineteen years of age, Five feet eight inches high, Fair complexion, Hazel eyes, Dark hair, and by occupation when enrolled, a Farmer. Given at Clarksburg W. Va, this Thirtieth day of July, 1865.
