TITLE LXX -- CRIMES .- Chapter 4-Sac. 5392.—Every person who, having taken an oath before a competent tribunal, officer, or person, in any case in which a law of the United States authorizes an eath to be administered, that he will restify, declare, depose, or certify truly, or that any written testimony, declaration, deposition, or certificate by him subscribed is true, wilfully, and contrary to such oath, states or subscribes any material matter which he does not believe to be true, is guilty of perjury, and shall be punished by a fine of not more than two thousand dollars, and by imprisonment at hard labor, not more than itwo rears, and shall, moreover, thereafter be incapable of giving testimony in any coust of the United States until such time as this judgment against him is reversed.
