The following information has been obtained from the files of this Office, and is respectfully furnished in reply to your inquiry:

It appears from the Records on file in this Office that

Rizzaro Cook was enrolled on the 9th day of Aug, 1862, at Pra du Chien, in Co. A

21st Regiment of Wis: Volunteers, to serve 3 years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Priv on the 9th day of Oct, 1862,

at Pra du Chien Wis in Co. A, 21st Regiment of Wis: Volunteers, to serve 3 years, or during the war.

On the Muster ^{out} Roll of Co. A of that Regiment for the months of dates June 20th, 1865, he is reported

present & mustered out with Co. on that date.
