in the spring of 1837 I moved on
the said S. E⁴ with my family and
have been an actual and bona
fide resident ^{therein} ever since; that my
improvements thereon consist of
a sod house 18 x 28, board roof and
floor, log stable 14 x 28, slab shed
14 x 20, chicken house of sod, 12 x 14,
milk house of sod 14 x 16, card or
out door cellar 10 x 12, smoke house
of slabs 6 x 6, 120 acres fenced with
posts and rails, 35 acres under
cultivation

That I have not since March 2nd
1889 perfected a pre-emption or
homestead title initiated prior to
said date - That the S²⁷ E⁴ &
Lots 1 and 2 of said Section 4 is
comparatively worthless for agri-
cultural purposes by reason of
a large draw running through
same, and its general hilly and
bluffy condition
