

ADDITIONAL HOMESTEAD.

[AFFIDAVIT.]

I, William A. Brooks, of Pleasant Grove Ripley County Mo  
 having filed my application, No. ~~1515~~ 3268, for an additional entry under the provisions of  
 Section 2306 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, do solemnly swear that on the 20<sup>th</sup>  
 day of June, 1868, I made a homestead entry of Forty
