On the matter of Final Discharge of James A. Nelson.

Attended Copy of Discharge from service
of United States

To all whom it may concern

Wherefore, that James A. Nelson
Private of Captain - - - - - Company
(1st Regt), 2nd Regiment of Michigan Infantry
volunteers, who was enrolled on the
Eighteenth day of February, one
thousand eight hundred and sixty four
to serve three years, on closing the war
is hereby discharged, from the service
of the United States, this nineteenth day
of May, 1865 at Detroit, Michigan
by means of telegraphed instructions
from war department, Dated, May
3rd 1865 -

No objection to his being recruited is
known to exist

And James A. Nelson now born
in - - - in the state of Ohio, is now
one year of age, five feet eleven inches high
dark complexion, blue eyes, brown hair
and by occupation when enrolled, a farmer
born at Detroit Michigan, this
nineteenth day of May 1865
