I, Elisha Ransom, of Pike Co. Illinois having filed my application, No. 3270, for an additional entry under the provisions of Section 2306 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, do solemnly swear that on the 27 day of August, 1866, I made a homestead entry of Eighty acres of public land at the U.
