This certifies that the official records (of which I am the lawful custodian) on file in this office show that John Lewis joined for duty and was enrolled as a private of Company "G" 15th Regiment Indiana Volunteers at La Fayette Ind. on the 14th day of June 1861 by Capt Burns, and that he was duly mustered into the military service of the United States at Indianapolis on the 14th day of June 1861 for the term of three years by Lt Col Wood Mustering Officer, Discharged Dec. 12th 1862
