Be it remembered that at a term of the District Court holden in and for Humboldt County, The State of Nebraska, on the 28th of March, 1893, there was present the Honorable William Neville sole presiding judge, and Alfred Hansen Sheriff and J Woodbridge Clerk of District Court, the following among other proceedings were had. Julius Fisher a Native of Germany and residing within the said State, made application to become a Citizen of the United States, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that he had declared an oath before the Clerk of the District Court of Buffalo County Nebraska, a court of record having territorial jurisdiction two years at least before that it was found to his intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce forever all allegiance to any foreign prince potentate state or sovereignty and particularly to the Emperor of Germany of whom he was a subject, and having an oath declared that he would support the Constitution of the United States, and renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince Potentate.
