
I am in receipt of your letter of September 21, 1907, enclosing \$1.65, and requesting a certified copy of your patent on the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 4, Tp. 19 N., R. 37 W.

The records of this office show that you made homestead entry No. 3610, May 16, 1899, for SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 4, Tp. 19 N., R. 37 W., proof was made May 31, 1904, and final certificate No. 3354 issued June 20, 1904 Sidney, now North Platte Nebraska. The case was suspended because more than fifteen days elapsed after proof was made before the certificate was issued, and no reason given by the Register as to the delay.

A re-examination of the case shows the proof to be satisfactory as to residence and cultivation, and the entry has therefore this day been relieved from suspension and approved for patenting, and the patent will issue in due course of business. \$1.65 is therefore returned.
