In view of the facts as above state and of the utter worthlessness of the above described land I would ask that my homestead right be restored and I be allowed to file on another tract of land as a homestead claim; The N. 2. And for that purpose I hereby relinquish all my right title and interest to homestead filing No. 1423. made on the 12th day of April 1895. on the N. 1/2 of N. 1/2 Sec. 32. T. 2. N. R. 1. E. Sec. 32. all in T. 2. N. R. 1. E. Range 57. W. of 68 W. Which Original filing with relinquishment is sent to the Alliance Land office, that being the office having jurisdiction over land claimed in Original filing.

I would therefore ask that my filing be allowed on the above described land being the N. 2. SW. 1/4 Sec. 3. T. 2. N. R. 1. E. Sec. 3. & 4. 20. R. 57. as in such cases provided by our Statute.
