Sir:

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5 day of May, 1882, requesting a "Statement of Service" of Ezekiel Anderson. The following information has been obtained from the files of this Office, and is furnished in reply to your inquiry.

In the case of Ezekiel Anderson there is no original Enlistment or Muster-in Roll showing him to have been enrolled or mustered into the service of the United States as an enlisted man in Company D of the 25<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Ohio Volunteers, on file in this Office up to date.

The Muster Rolls of Company D of that Regiment contain the following evidence of service:

It is stated he was Enrolled as a private July 19, 1861. and Mustered in July 19, 1861 at Columbus Ohio for 3 years Transferred to the 12<sup>th</sup> Ohio Inf Batty, and Mustered out on Individual Muster out Roll July 20, 1864. at Columbus Ohio
