"G." 15 Regiment Indiana Volunteers at
La Fayette Ind. on the 14th day of June 1861 by
Capt Burns, and that he was duly mustered
into the Military Service of the United States
at Indianapolis on the 14 day of June 1861
for the term of three years, by Lt Col Wood
Mustering Officer.

That he was discharged December
12th 1862 at Indianapolis Ind. by reason of
Surgeon Certificate of disability, issued by
Dr. Bibbs the hospital surgeon
That he is now and has been since
Jan 29. 1871 a pensioner of the United States
by reason of disability incurred in the
service. John Lewis
