at *Westville Ind*  
for *3* years or during the war, and mustered  
into service as a *Foot* in *Co. G,*  
*15 Reg't Ind.* June 14, 1861,  
and discharged as a *Foot*  
Dec. 12 1862 on *P. C. G. O.*  
because of displacement of the  
radius at the radii-ulnar  
articulation, impairing the use of  
the arm so that he cannot use his  
musket. Probable cause an attack  
of acute Rheumatism.
