Be it Remembered, That on the
Seventeenth day of May, in the year one
Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety Four
John B. Heintz, appeared in the District
Court (the said court being a Court of Record
having common law jurisdiction
and a clerk and seal) and applied to the
said Court to be admitted to become a
Citizen of the United States of America
pursuant to the several acts of the
Congress of the United States of America
for that purpose made and provided
and the said applicant having thereupon
produced to the Court such evidence
made such declaration and renuncia-
tion, and taken such oaths as are by the
said acts required.

Whereupon, it was ordered by the said
Court, that the said applicant be admitted
and he was accordingly admitted by
the said Court to be a Citizen of the United
States of America.
