


POWER TO LOCATE.

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, *Ezekiel Anderson* of the county of *Quinn*, State of *Iowa*, do hereby make, constitute and appoint **W. C. HILL**, of Washington, D. C., my true and lawful Attorney, giving to my said Attorney full power for me and in my name, place and stead, to select, make application for me and in my name, to sign said application, and to locate at any Land Office in the United States any land that I may be entitled to enter under the provisions of Section 2306 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, under which I am entitled to enter *Eighty* acres in addition to my *Eighty* acres of homestead. *8 1/2 of NE 1/4 Sec 14. T. 21. R. 57 West*

And I further authorize and empower my said Attorney to receive the Duplicate Certificate of such entry, and to demand, receive and receipt for the Patent that may be issued by the United States Government for said Land:

Granting and giving my said Attorney full power to appoint a substitute, and hereby ratifying and confirming each and every act which my said Attorney or his substitute may do or cause to be done in the premises by virtue of these presents.
